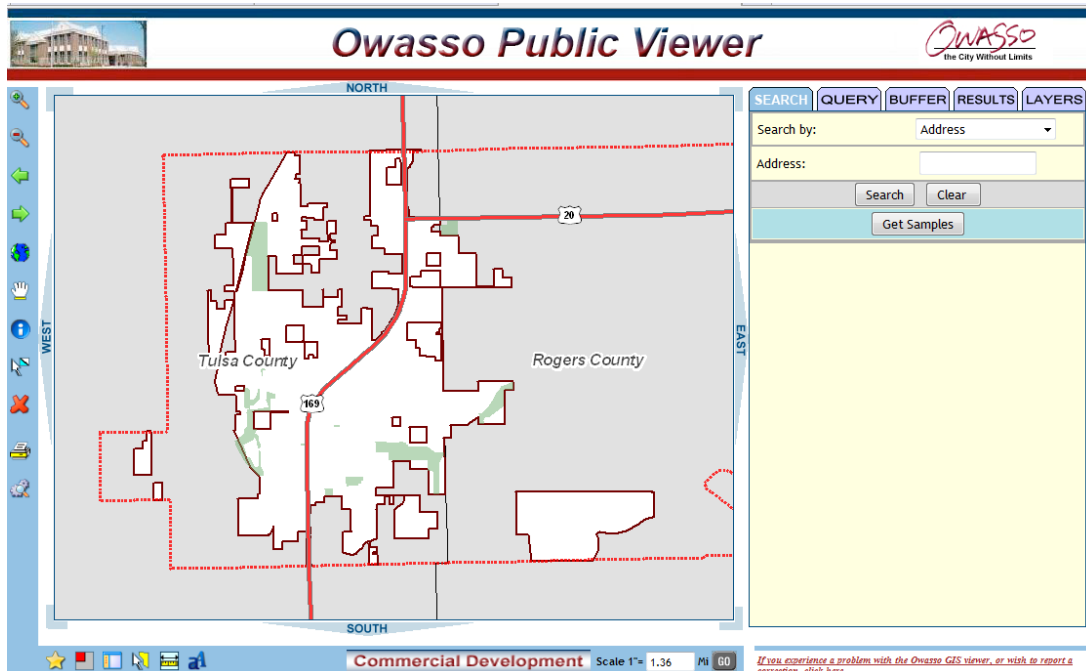
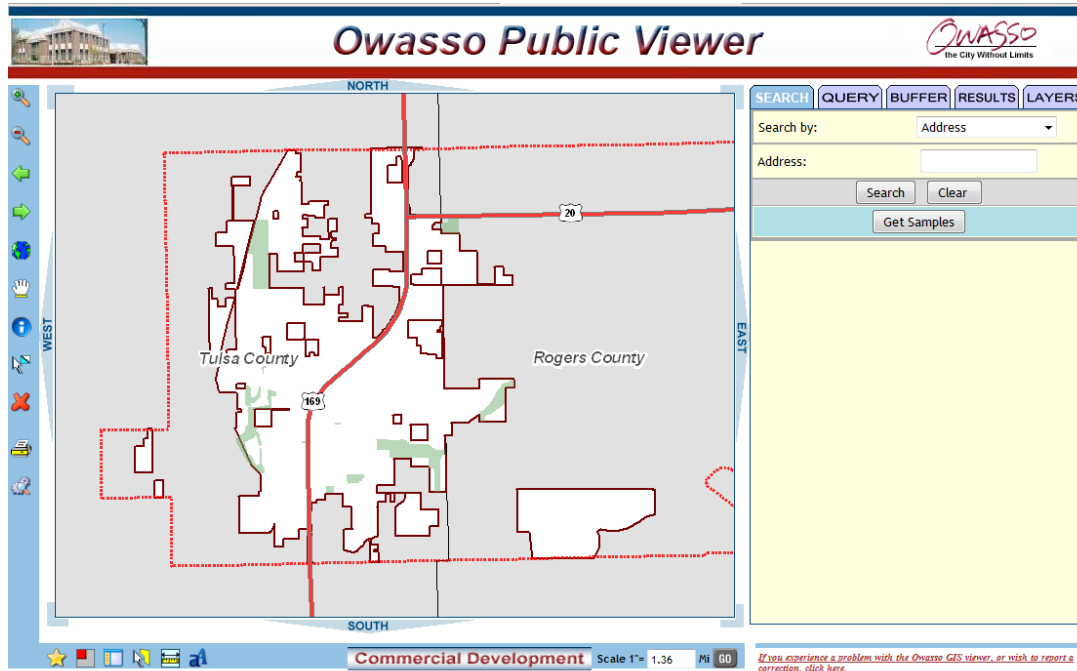

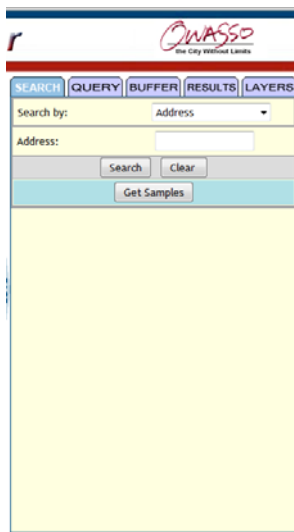
Tools

	Zoom In	Select, then click and drag pointer on the map to zoom in.
	Zoom Out	Select, then click and drag pointer on map to zoom out.
	Zoom Previous	
	Zoom Next	
	Zoom Full Extent	Returns the map to the original zoom showing full city.
	Pan	When selected allows you to move in any direction on map. Click and drag.
	Identify Features	Select a map feature, then click this tool to show any visible attributes.
	Search by Box or Point	
	Clear Selection/Features	Clear any features or selections made.
	Print/Email Map	Opens print email form for creation of map. Can save and email in PDF form.
	Hide/Show Advanced Tools	Hide or Show the advanced tools located at the bottom of map.

Advanced Tools



	Bookmark	Create a map, then bookmark it so you can return to it at a later time.
	Overview Map	This will place a full size map in upper right corner indicating where map is zoomed to. Button will toggle on and off.
	Map Legend	Selecting this will display the map legend at the Right side of the map.
	Select Features By Polygon	
	Measure Distance/Area	Provides measurement between two points, or calculate the area inside a polygon
	Drawing Control	Allows for the selection of drawing objects to be placed on a map, including text. The map can then be printed, emailed or written to PDF.

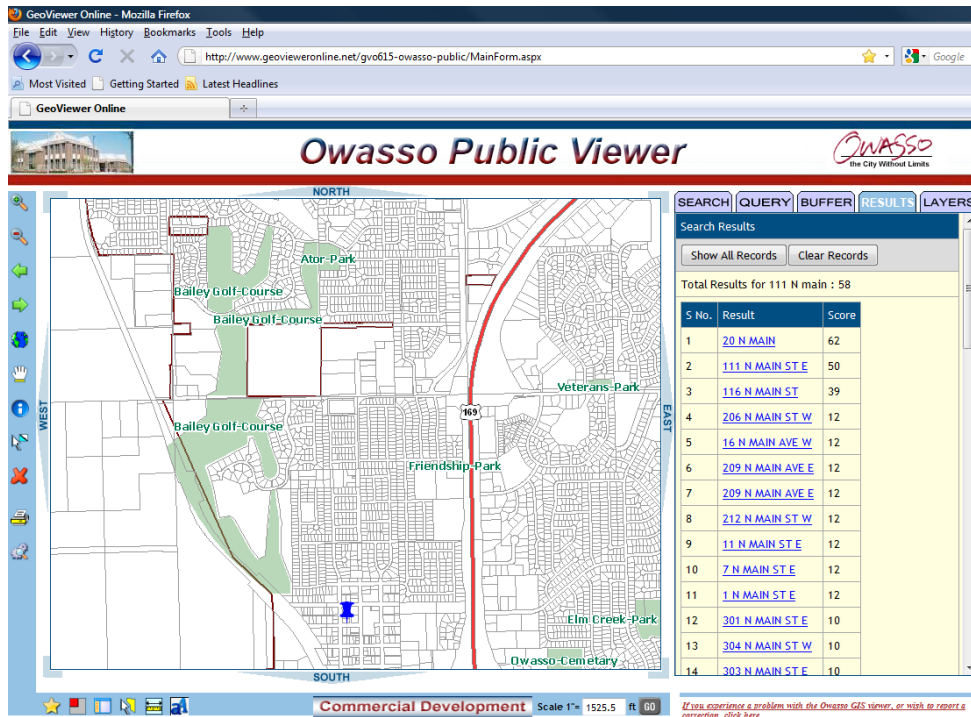
The search tab allows the viewer to search for an address to view on the map.

Type an address in the Address field to view possible matches. The matches will be listed and a pin will be shown on the map to indicate the address entered.

Select any of the possible matches to change the location, or select Clear to clear selections, then click on the Search tab to enter a new search.

If you are unsure of the correct address format, select Get Samples to view sample data formats.

The image below shows the location of 111 N Main on the map and possible matches, based on the Main address.

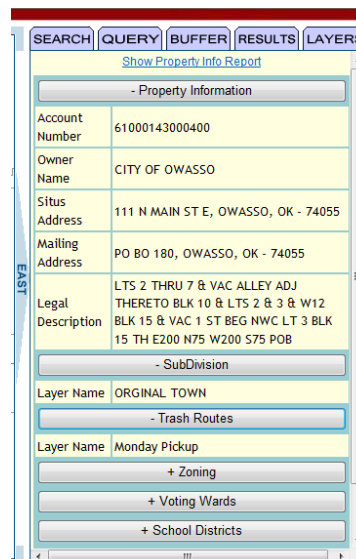


Once the correct address has been selected from the possible matches, a list of attributes for that address will become visible. The list appears collapsed to enable the user to see all fields. Simply click on the feature you wish to see more detail to expand.
