

Information on Sewer Averaging Method

The City of Owasso utilizes an averaging method to compute the sewer charge for your bills. Here is how it works:

Your sewer charge is based on your water consumption during the months of December, January and February. We take the total usage and divide it by three to calculate your sewer rate. This average will be your sewer rate charge from April to the following March.

For example:

December's water usage is 9,000 gallons

January's water usage is 4,000 gallons

February's water usage is 8,000 gallons

Sewer average for this account is $(9+4+8)/3 = 7,000$ gallons average.

This calculation method is to assist customers who in the summer months may utilize more water to fill up a pool, water their lawn, etc.

If you have a leak during the months of the sewer averaging, bring in your receipts where you have had the leak repaired and we will adjust your sewer average accordingly.
